MOSCATO 2010

VARIETY:

100% white Frontignac grapes.

REGION:

Southern Barossa, Lyndoch Valley.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

This is a clean and clear, fragrant and floral perfumed wine with the distinctive Muscat nose. It is delicately sweet with hints of pineapple and passionfruit, balanced with a light spritz finish and a crisp, zesty, refreshing mouth feel.

Refreshing and aromatic, this is an excellent aperitif wine. It is great with cheese and pate, wonderfully complements spicy food and is lovely as a light dessert wine.

A great 'festive wine', to enjoy anytime... just on its own.

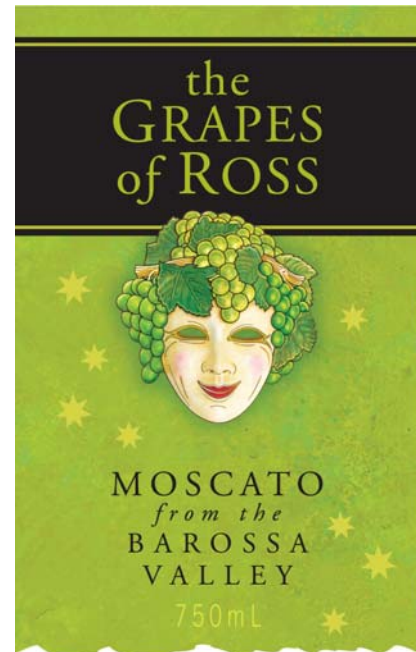

RUBY TUESDAY ROSÉ 2010

VARIETY:

Shiraz and Sangiovese blend.

REGION:

Southern Barossa, Lyndoch Valley.

OAK MATURATION:

16 months in French oak Hogsheads.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

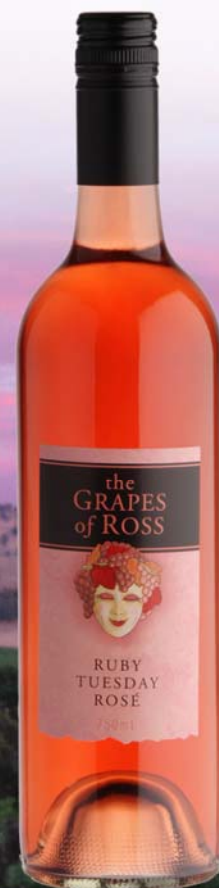
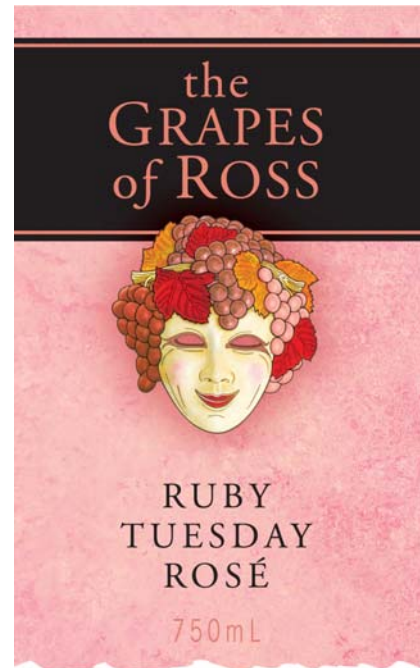
Soft, subtle, violet and cherry characteristics of Sangiovese, with rich, ripe, fruit driven Barossa Shiraz imparting the full mouth feel to the wine. It has a radiant ruby sheen with fragrant rose and lifted soft attractive berry aromas and a touch of spice. On the palate, succulent, red berry fruits and cherries tantalise in the softest hint of spritz. There remains a crispness and acidity which balances the ripeness of the full fruit flavours.

Recommended with seafood, Asian and French cuisine and salad dishes.

OLD BUSH VINE GRENACHE 2006

VARIETY:

Mature 40 year old Grenache bush vines.

REGION:

Southern Barossa, Lyndoch Valley.

OAK MATURATION:

16 months in French oak Hogsheads.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

Slow ripening and lower yields have produced this 'earthy' and flavoursome wine with ripe berry fruit and a touch of confection typical to many a Barossa Grenache.

A 'warm and generous' wine with darker, brick red tones, it is medium bodied, clean and fruit driven with raspberry, cherry and some savoury spice. This wine has several years of cellaring potential.

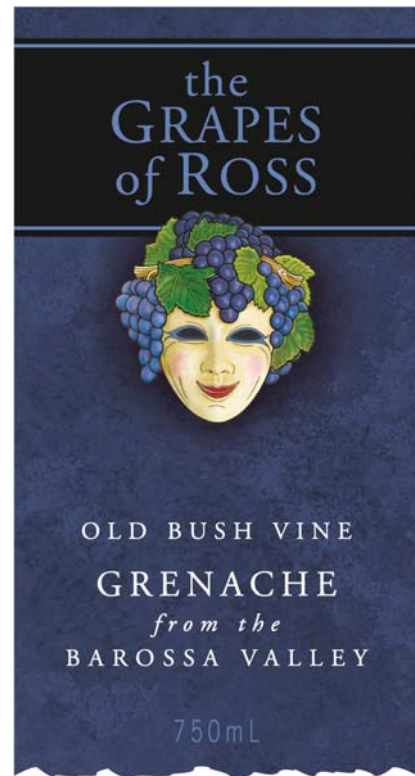

24 months in French and American oak hogsheads.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

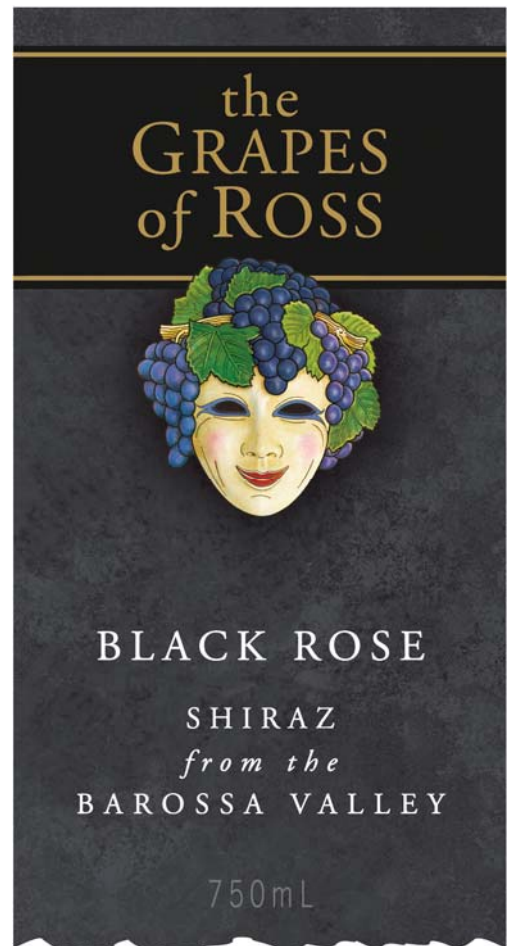

It displays rich, ripe Barossa fruit with sweet mulberries, plums and toasty oak characters lending a lovely balance and length to the soft tannin finish on the palate.

OAK MATURATION:

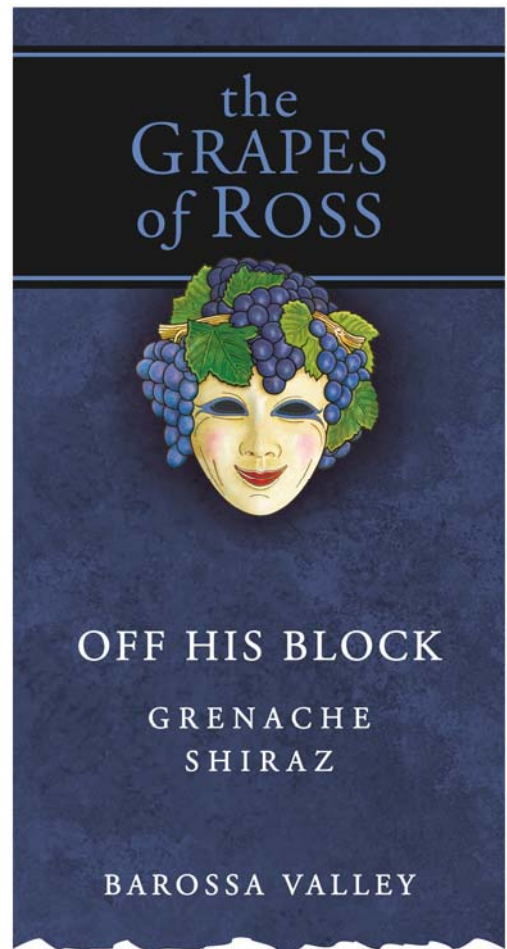
French and American Oak hogsheads.
