

Tasting Notes

OLD BUSH VINE GRENACHE 2006

VARIETY:

Mature 40 year old Grenache bush vines.

REGION:

Southern Barossa, Lyndoch Valley.

OAK MATURATION:

16 months in French oak Hogsheads.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

Slow ripening and lower yields have produced this 'earthy' and flavoursome wine with ripe berry fruit and a touch of confection typical to many a Barossa Grenache.

A 'warm and generous' wine with darker, brick red tones, it is medium bodied, clean and fruit driven with raspberry, cherry and some savoury spice. This wine has several years of cellaring potential.

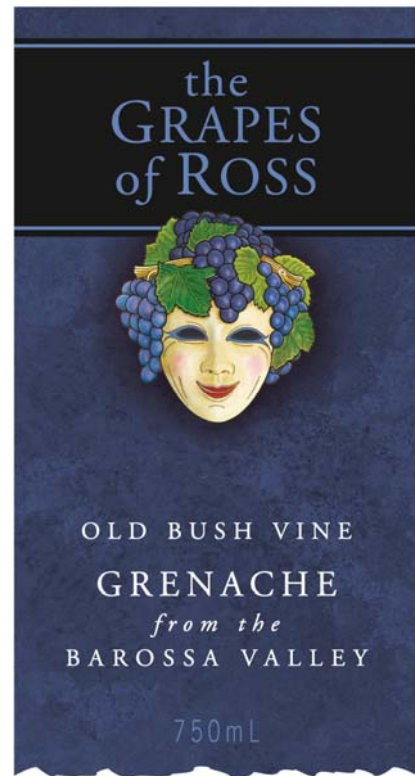
Will complement most meat dishes.
