BLACK ROSE SHIRAZ 2007

VARIETY:

100% Shiraz from mature 40 year old vines.

REGION:

Southern Barossa, Lyndoch Valley.

OAK MATURATION:

24 months in French and American oak hogsheads.

WINEMAKERS COMMENTS:

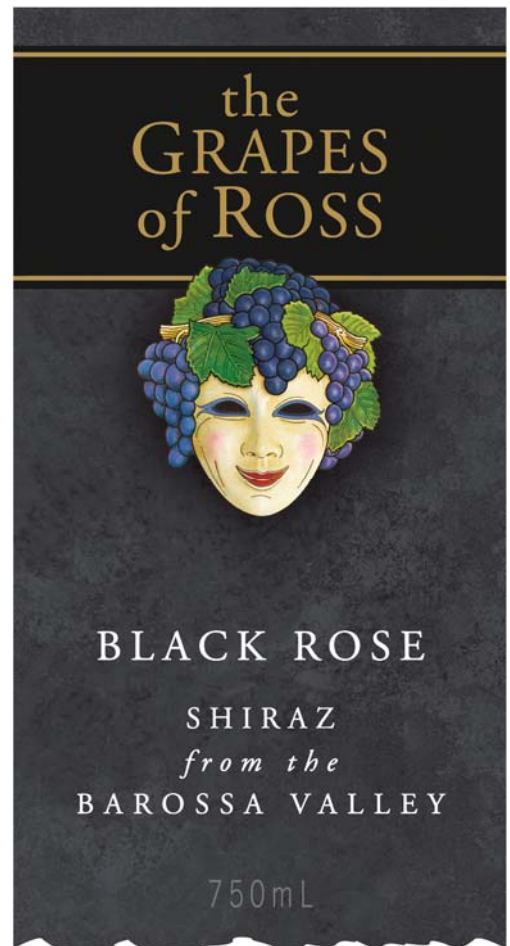
An elegant style typical of this region, this wine has a vibrant, 'black rose' colour with some of this fragrance contributing to the gorgeous aromatics. It displays rich, ripe Barossa fruit with sweet mulberries, plums and toasty oak characters lending a lovely balance and length to the soft tannin finish on the palate.
